WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY by Advice Letter No. 571-G, filed April 15, 1968, having requested authority under Sections 455, 490 and 491 of the Public Utilities Code to make effective certain revisions in its tariff schedules for meter readings taken on and after May 15, 1968, as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 8104-G through 8128-G, inclusive, and

WHEREAS: The proposed revisions fully reflect savings in costs of gas purchased from El Paso Natural Gas Company; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Sections 490 and 491 of the Public Utilities Code to make said sheets effective for meter readings taken on and after May 15, 1968.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above sheets be marked to show that such sheets were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1411.
