SUBJECT: Request for Deviation from General Order No. 58-A,
 Pacific Gas and Electric Company

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY has by letter dated August 18, 1967, requested a deviation from General Order No. 58-A, which requires that no gas meter shall be allowed to remain in service more than 10 years from the date when last tested without being retested; and

WHEREAS: The utility has submitted a meter performance plan, similar to those authorized for other major gas utilities; and

WHEREAS: The adoption of this program will permit a better and more accurate control over the performance of gas meters in the future, and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Pacific Gas and Electric Company is hereby authorized to deviate from Rule 24(a) of General Order No. 58-A, under conditions of its letter dated August 18, 1967, until July 1, 1969, or until the effective date of any revisions hereafter made to such general order, whichever is earlier.
