SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Changes in Tariff Schedules Which Will Result in Increased Charges

WHEREAS: SAN DIEGO GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY by Advice Letter No. 238-G filed August 13, 1968 having requested authority under Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to revise Rule No. 20, Gas Main Extensions, and Rule No. 21, Gas Service Extensions, by increasing charges for excess gas pipe footage, as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 1091-G to 1096-G, inclusive, and

WHEREAS: Said rules contain provisions covering revision of these charges when unit installation costs have changed by more than 10% and the proposed unit charges, based on 1967 construction costs, exceed the costs now on file by more than 10%, and

WHEREAS: The revision of these unit charges is being accomplished in accordance with the procedure authorized by Ordering Paragraph 5 of Decision No. 59801, dated March 22, 1960, in Case No. 5945, and

WHEREAS: We find that the increases are justified; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to make said sheets effective on September 12, 1968.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above sheets be marked to show that such sheets were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1418.
