SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Contract for Temporary Sale of Gas to be Effective on Less Than Statutory Notice.

WHEREAS: PACIFIC LIGHTING SERVICE AND SUPPLY COMPANY by Advice Letter No. 45, filed October 23, 1968, requests authority to carry out the terms and conditions of a letter agreement dated October 18, 1968 covering the transfer and resale to Southern California Gas Company and Southern Counties Gas Company of California of gas obtained by Pacific Lighting Service and Supply Company from Pacific Gas and Electric Company, pursuant to a contract dated October 4, 1968, and

WHEREAS: PACIFIC LIGHTING SERVICE AND SUPPLY COMPANY has been authorized by Resolution No. G-1420 to purchase any such gas that Pacific Gas and Electric Company makes available, and

WHEREAS: No finding is being made as to the reasonableness of the charge for the handling of gas by Pacific Lighting Service and Supply Company; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Sections 491 and 532 of the Public Utilities Code to furnish the service under the conditions in accordance with the terms and conditions of the contract and to make the contract effective on November 1, 1968.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that granting of such authority shall not be construed as a finding as to the reasonableness of difference between the unit cost of gas paid by Pacific Lighting Service and Supply Company to Pacific Gas and Electric Company and the rate to be charged to Southern California Gas Company and Southern Counties Gas Company of California.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the contract hereinabove authorized be marked to show that it was authorized under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1421.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Pacific Lighting Service and Supply Company shall notify the Commission of the date of termination of said contract within thirty days after date of termination.
