SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Changes in a Rate Schedule on Less
Than Statutory Notice

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY by Advice No. 747 filed November 20, 1968, having requested authority under Sections 455 and 491 of the Public Utilities Code to make revisions in its tariff schedules as designated in Schedule No. G-60, Resale Natural Gas Service, and to file a Sixth Supplemental to a Gas Service Agreement with the City of Long Beach as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 10257-G through 10262-G, inclusive, effective on less than 30 days' notice, namely, December 1, 1968, and

WHEREAS: These changes provide for further extension and modification of the service agreement dated March 22, 1961, covering sales of gas to the City of Long Beach, and

WHEREAS: Similar changes were authorized by Resolution No. G-1287, dated June 29, 1965, Resolution No. G-1314, dated March 29, 1966, and Resolution No. G-1405 dated December 27, 1967, and

WHEREAS: The reduction in the daily contract demand will result in an annual demand charge reduction of \$151,800; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 491 of the Public Utilities Code to make said sheets effective on December 1, 1968.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above sheets be marked to show that such sheets were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1425.


