RESOLUTION

SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Deviations from Filed Tariffs for
 a Gas Main Extension

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY by Advice Letter No. 579-G filed January 20, 1969, having requested authority under its Rule No. 15.E.7 and Section 532 of the Public Utilities Code to deviate from its filed tariff schedules by waiving gas main extension advances in the extension of gas service to the towns of Jackson and Sutter Creek and the Community of Martell as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 8200-G to 8203-G, inclusive, and

WHEREAS: A survey made by the utility indicates that all such advances would be returned within the first year of operations, therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 532 of the Public Utilities Code to make said tariff sheets effective on February 19, 1969.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above sheets be marked to show that such sheets were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1427.
