SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Bill Adjustment to Compensate for Slow Meter Readings

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN COUNTIES GAS COMPANY, by letter filed January 23, 1969, having requested authority to render a bill adjustment to Southern California Edison Company for charges of \$245,553.09 resulting from underbillings due to a defective meter, and

WHEREAS: The nineteen month period of error with a meter registration 2.5% slow has been definitely determined for this commercial service as required by Southern Counties Gas Company's filed Rule No. 16, and

WHEREAS: Southern Counties Gas Company and the customer are in agreement as to the amount of underbilling, therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Southern Counties Gas Company be authorized to render a bill adjustment in the said amount of \$245,553.09 for underbillings resulting from the defective meter.


