SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Contract Filed Under Section X, Paragraph A,
of General Order No. 96-A.

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY by Advice No. 754 filed March 14,
1969, having requested authority under Section 532 of the Public Utilities
Code to make effective a replacement contract dated January 7, 1969 with
The Carbon Black and Synthetic Rubber Division of Ashland Chemical Company
covering the exemption of their reactors from the standby equipment
required by Schedule No. G-53T, and

WHEREAS: The present contract, dated October 10, 1961, will be cancelled
and superseded by this revised contract, and

WHEREAS: Deviation from the standby requirements of Interruptible Schedule
No. G-50 was previously authorized for this service by Decision No. 62851
in Application No. 43864, and

WHEREAS: The customer elects to transfer to Schedule No. G-53T for
interruptible service; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 532 of the Public
Utilities Code to carry out the terms and conditions of said contract and
to continue the exemption of the reactors from the standby requirements
under Schedule No. G-53T.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that said contract be marked to show that it was
authorized under resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the
State of California No. G-1432.
