R E S O L U T I O N

**SUBJECT:** Order Authorizing Changes in Tariff Schedules Which Will  
 Result in Rate Increases

**WHEREAS:** SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY by Advice No. 759, filed April 11, 1969, having requested authority under Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to increase the rates in Schedules G-53T, G-54 and G-56, for supplemental gas delivered to Monolith Portland Cement Company, as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 10381-G to 10385-G, inclusive, and

**WHEREAS:** The estimated revenue effect of the increase in rates for Monolith supplemental service is included in the increase in revenue for regular interruptible service authorized by Decision No. 75429 in Application No. 50713, and

**WHEREAS:** We find that the increases resulting from the above changes are justified; therefore, good cause appearing,

**IT IS ORDERED** that authority be granted under Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to make the above sheets effective on May 11, 1969.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the above sheets be marked to show that such sheets were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1435.
