RESOLUTION

SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Deviations from Filed Tariffs for a Gas Main Extension

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY by Advice Letter No. 583-G, filed April 23, 1969, having requested authority under its Rule No. 15, Section E.7., Rule No. 16, Section I, and Section 532 of the Public Utilities Code to deviate from its filed tariff schedules by waiving gas main extension advances and requiring a performance deposit in the extension of natural gas service to the town of Blue Lake, Humboldt County as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 8241-G to 8243-G, inclusive, and

WHEREAS: Such deviations from filed tariff schedules will facilitate procurement of the necessary applications for natural gas service; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 532 of the Public Utilities Code to make said tariff sheets effective on May 23, 1969.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above sheets be marked to show that such sheets were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1436.
