SUBJECT: Request for Extension of Deviation From General Order No. 58-A, Pacific Gas and Electric Company

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, by letter dated June 24, 1969, requested a two-year extension of a deviation from Rule 24(a) of General Order No. 58-A, authorized by Resolution No. G-1413, dated June 11, 1968; and

WHEREAS: The utility has stated in the above letter and its letter of June 16, 1969 the conditions under which it seeks an extension of the deviation, and

WHEREAS: The scheduled meter removals outlined in its June 16, 1969 letter will increase the overall reliability of its meters in service; and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Pacific Gas and Electric Company is hereby authorized to deviate from Rule 24(a) of General Order No. 58-A, under conditions of its letters dated June 16 and 24, 1969, until July 1, 1971, or until the effective date of any revisions hereafter made to such general order, whichever is earlier.
