SUBJECT: Request for Extension of Deviation From Meter Testing
 Requirement General Order No. 58-A, Southern Counties Gas
 Company of California

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN COUNTIES GAS COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA, by letter dated
 July 25, 1969, requested a three-year extension of a deviation from Rule 24(a) of
 General Order No. 58-A, authorized by Resolution No. G-1320, dated May 17, 1966;
 and

WHEREAS: The utility has discussed with the staff a program for continuation
 of the general benefits of the quality meter control program with a view toward a
 more level rate of change and costs under such a program; and

WHEREAS: The level of meter removals for the meter removal program, both
 on a routine and planned basis, should be maintained at a level between 50,000 and
 60,000 meters per year; and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Southern Counties Gas Company of California is hereby
 authorized to deviate from Rule 24(a) of General Order No. 58-A, under conditions
 of its letter dated July 25, 1969, until July 1, 1972, or until the effective
 date of any revisions hereafter made to such general order, whichever is earlier.
