WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORFIA GAS COMPANY by Advice Letter No. 777, filed October 17, 1969, and SOUTHERN COUNTIES GAS COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA by Advice Letter No. 609, filed October 17, 1969, having requested authority under Section 532 of the Public Utilities Code to make effective on November 16, 1969, joint letter contracts between the two gas utilities and (1) The City of Los Angeles Department of Water and Power and (2) Southern California Edison Company, and a letter contract between Southern California Gas Company and the City of Pasadena Water and Power Department, for the sale of gas on an emergency basis for the period November 16, 1969 through April 14, 1970, and
