SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Changes in Tariff Schedules Which Will Result in Rate Increases on Less Than Statutory Notice.

WHEREAS: PACIFIC LIGHTING SERVICE COMPANY, by Advice No. 53, filed November 20, 1969, having requested authority under Sections 454 and 491 of the Public Utilities Code to make effective on less than 30 days' notice, namely November 1, 1969, an increased Monthly Aggregate Demand Charge to Southern California Gas Company and Southern Counties Gas Company of California as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 301-G and 302-G, and

WHEREAS: Pacific Lighting Service Company requests that this filing be made effective on November 1, 1969 to offset an equivalent annual increase of \$4,316,125 in demand charges by Transwestern Pipeline Company under its Schedule CDQ-1, effective the same date, and

WHEREAS: We find that such increases resulting from the above changes in the tariff schedules are justified; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Sections 454 and 491 of the Public Utilities Code to make said sheets effective on November 1, 1969.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above tariff sheets shall be marked to show that such sheets were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1456.
