SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Changes in Territorial Boundary Which Will Result in Technical Increases

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN COUNTIES GAS COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA by Advice Letter No. 618, filed December 29, 1969, having requested authority under Sections 454 and 455 of the Public Utilities Code to make revisions in its common territorial boundary line with Southern California Gas Company as established by Decision No. 56878, dated June 24, 1958 in joint Application No. 39636 by modifying the common boundary so as to eliminate potential rate administration and distribution problems as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 5100-G to 5104-G, inclusive, and

WHEREAS: Portions of the area transferred to Southern California Gas Company will be subject to potentially increased charges over the rates now in effect, thus resulting in technical increases, and

WHEREAS: These boundary revisions coincide with like changes concurrently granted by Resolution No. G-1464 for Southern California Gas Company, and

WHEREAS: We find that such technical increases resulting from the boundary line revisions are justified; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to make the above sheets effective on January 28, 1970.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above sheets be marked to show that they were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1465.
