SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Changes in Gas Tariff Schedules on Less Than Statutory Notice Which Will Result in Reduced Rates

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY by Advice Letter No. 592-G, filed December 30, 1969, having requested authority under Section 491 of the Public Utilities Code to reduce present applicable rates to reflect a reduction in the Federal Income Tax Surcharge as set forth in Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 8276-G through 8301-G, inclusive, to be effective on less than statutory notice, namely, January 1, 1970, and

WHEREAS: Such aforementioned revisions result in revenue reductions of \$950,000 on an annual basis, therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 491 of the Public Utilities Code to make said sheets effective on January 1, 1970.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above sheets be marked to show that such sheets were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1466.
