SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Changes in Tariff Schedules on Less than Statutory Notice

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY by Advice Letter No. 594-G, filed January 27, 1970, having requested authority under Section 491 of the Public Utilities Code to make certain revisions in its tariff schedules in compliance with Decision No. 56967 as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 8363-G to 8401-G, inclusive, to be effective on less than statutory notice, namely January 31, 1970, and

WHEREAS: Such aforementioned revisions reflect revenue reductions resulting from the utility's annual zoning review, therefore, good cause appearing,


