SUBJECT: Order Authorizing the Transmittal of Utilities' Gas Leak Reports to the U. S. Department of Transportation, Office of Pipeline Safety

WHEREAS: The Office of Pipeline Safety of the U. S. Department of Transportation has promulgated its requirements for the reporting of gas leaks by gas operators, Federal Register, Vol. 35, No. 5, and

WHEREAS: The requirements provide that written gas leak reports for intrastate facilities, subject to the jurisdiction of the state agency pursuant to certification under Section 5(a) of the Natural Gas Pipeline Safety Act, may be submitted in duplicate to the state agency for further transmittal of one copy to the Office of Pipeline Safety, and

WHEREAS: Accident information may be made public information on order of the Commission, and good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that all gas utilities serving 100,000 customers or more subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission shall submit two copies of each report called for in Part 191 of Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations, to this Commission. The Secretary of the Commission is hereby authorized to transmit one copy of each such report to the U. S. Department of Transportation, Office of Pipeline Safety.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the copy transmitted to the U. S. Department of Transportation is hereby made public to the U. S. Department of Transportation within the meaning of this Commission's General Order No. 66-B and Section 583 of the Public Utilities Code of the State of California.
