SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Changes in Tariff Schedules Which Will Result in Rate Increase

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY by Advice No. 793, filed March 2, 1970, having requested authority under Sections 454 and 455 of the Public Utilities Code to make revisions in its tariff schedules as designated in Schedule No. G-60, Resale Natural Gas Service, and set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 11001-G through 11003-G, inclusive, effective on 30 days' notice, and

WHEREAS: These changes include an increase in the Daily Contract Demand Rate from \$2.976 to \$3.125 per Mcf and a decrease in the Commodity Rate from 32.240ϕ per Mcf to 31.75ϕ per Mcf, and

WHEREAS: The City of Long Beach requested this shift between rate components, and

WHEREAS: We find that such increases resulting from the above changes in the tariff schedules are justified; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to make said sheets effective on April 1, 1970.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above sheets shall be marked to show that such sheets were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1475.
