RESOLUTION

SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Contract Amendment Filed Under Section 532 of the Public Utilities Code

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, jointly with Pacific Lighting Service Company, Southern California Gas Company and Southern Counties Gas Company of California by letter dated February 25, 1970 requests authority to carry out the terms of a letter agreement covering the further amendment of a contract authorized by Resolution No. G-1294, dated September 21, 1965, as amended, and

WHEREAS: This letter agreement dated September 23, 1969, creates one new point of delivery near Morro Bay to provide Southern Counties Gas Company with a temporary emergency supply of gas by PG&E in the event of failure of its Atascadero to Morro Bay supply system, and

WHEREAS: In all other respects the contract shall be subject to the provisions of Resolution No. G-1294 as amended by Resolution No. G-1330; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 532 of the Public Utilities Code to carry out the terms and conditions of said amending letter agreement and to make this contract modification effective on April 1, 1970.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the amendment hereinabove authorized be marked to show that it was authorized under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1476.
