SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Contract Filed Under Section X, Paragraph A of General Order No. 96-A to Deviate from Filed Tariff Schedules

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY by Advice Letter No. 797 filed April 24, 1970, having requested authority under Section X, Paragraph A, of General Order No. 96-A and Section 532 of the Public Utilities Code to make effective on regular statutory notice a contract executed March 30, 1970, with Toscopetro Corporation for interruptible gas service under Schedule No. G-53T to its steam boilers, petroleum oil stills and heaters, and hydrogen plant, and

WHEREAS: Said contract deviates from the filed tariff schedules with respect to waiving standby requirements specified in Special Condition 2 of Schedule No. G-53T for gas used as a raw material or as a fuel in the production of hydrogen, and

WHEREAS: The Commission previously authorized this type deviation for these facilities prior to the sale of the plant by Signal Oil and Gas Company to Toscopetro Corporation; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 532 of the Public Utilities Code to carry out the terms and conditions of this contract.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that said contract be marked to show that it was authorized under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1479.
