SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Deviations from Filed Tariffs for a Gas Main Extension

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY by Advice Letter No. 599-G, filed May 25, 1970, having requested authority under its Rule No. 15, Section E.7., and Section 532 of the Public Utilities Code to deviate from its filed tariff schedules by waiving gas main extension advances and requiring performance deposits in the extension of natural gas service to the towns of Valley Springs and San Andreas, Calaveras County as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 8485-G to 8489-G, inclusive, and

WHEREAS: Such deviations from filed tariff schedules will facilitate procurement of the necessary applications for natural gas service; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 532 of the Public Utilities Code to make said sheets effective on June 24, 1970.
