**SUBJECT:** Order Authorizing Contracts Filed Under Section X, Paragraph A, of General Order No. 96-A, to be Effective on Regular Statutory Notice

**WHEREAS:** SAN DIEGO GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY by Advice Letter No. 253-G, filed June 12, 1970, having requested authority under Section X, Paragraph A, of General Order No. 96-A, and Section 532 of the Public Utilities Code to make effective on regular statutory notice a contract executed June 3, 1970, with Avco Community Developers, Inc. for firm industrial and interruptible gas service to supply Bernardo Industrial Park in Rancho Bernardo, California, and

**WHEREAS:** Said contract contains deviations from the filed gas tariffs with respect to (1) waiving the one year limitation on refundable allowances for load increases and (2) basing refund allowances on both firm industrial and interruptible loads, and

**WHEREAS:** San Diego Gas & Electric Company believes it is logical in the case of an industrial park gas main extension to use any excess customer allowances to generate refunds to the developer; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 532 of the Public Utilities Code to carry out the terms and conditions of this contract.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that said contract be marked to show that it was authorized under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1483.
