Order Authorizing Changes in Gas Tariff Schedules on Less Than Statutory Notice Which Will Result in Reduced Rates

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY by Advice Letter No. 601-G, filed June 24, 1970, having requested authority under Section 491 of the Public Utilities Code to reduce present applicable rates to reflect the reduction in the Federal Income Tax Surcharge and a decrease in offset charges related to gas purchased from Pacific Gas Transmission Company as set forth in Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 8490-G through 8515-G, inclusive, to be effective on less than statutory notice, namely, July 1, 1970, and

WHEREAS: Such aforementioned revisions result in revenue reductions of \$1,929,000 on an annual basis, therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 491 of the Public Utilities Code to make said sheets effective on July 1, 1970.
