WHEREAS: SOUTHWEST GAS CORPORATION, by letter dated June 4, 1970, requested permission to retain the reduced cost of gas purchased for service in its San Bernardino County service area from Pacific Gas and Electric Company, from January 1, 1970 to January 30, 1970, and

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY, in Decision No. 76655, was authorized to raise its commodity rates on January 31, 1970 to the same level as prior to January 1, 1970, and


WHEREAS: SOUTHWEST GAS CORPORATION by not being permitted to place offset increases into effect immediately, incurred unrecoverable additional costs, therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Southwest Gas Corporation is authorized to retain the reduced cost of gas for the period January 1, 1970 through January 30, 1970.
