WHEREAS: The proposed refund plans reflect savings in costs of gas during the period October 1, 1968, through July 5, 1969, and


WHEREAS: The refunds are proposed to be distributed among all eligible gas customers; good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Southern California Gas Company and Pacific Lighting Service Company be granted authority to place into effect the refund plans filed September 16, 1970.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Southern California Gas Company and Pacific Lighting Service Company shall keep records of the refunds made and submit reports on their disposition to this Commission, together with a proposal for final disposition of any amounts unrefunded, by April 1, 1971
