SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Changes in Tariff Schedules Which Will Result in Increased Charges

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY by Advice Letter No. 604-G, having requested authority under Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to revise Rule No. 15, Gas Main Extensions, by increasing the charge for excess gas main footage, as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 8528-G to 8530-G, inclusive, and

WHEREAS: Said rule provides for the revision of this charge when unit installation costs have changed by more than 10% and the proposed main extension unit charge, based on 1969 construction costs, will exceed the charge now on file, and

WHEREAS: The revision of this unit charge is being accomplished in accordance with the procedure authorized by Ordering Paragraph 5 of Decision No. 59801, dated March 22, 1960, in Case No. 5945, and

WHEREAS: We find that the increases are justified; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to make said sheets effective on November 12, 1970.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above sheets be marked to show that such sheets were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1500.
