R E S O L U T I O N

**SUBJECT:** Order Authorizing Changes in Tariff Schedules Which Will Result in Increased Charges

**WHEREAS:** SOUTHWEST GAS CORPORATION by Advice Letter No. 78, filed October 22, 1970, having requested authority under Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to revise Rule No. 15, Gas Main Extensions, and Rule No. 16, Gas Service Extensions by increasing charges applicable in Placer County for excess gas pipe footage, as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 486-G to 496-G, inclusive, and

**WHEREAS:** Said rules provide for the revision of these charges when installation costs have changed by more than 10% and the proposed unit charges for Placer County service exceed the costs now on file; and

**WHEREAS:** The revision of these unit charges is being accomplished in accordance with the procedure authorized by Ordering Paragraph 5 of Decision No. 59801, dated March 22, 1960, in Case No. 5945, and

**WHEREAS:** We find that the increases are justified; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to make said sheets effective on November 21, 1970.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above sheets be marked to show that such sheets were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1501.
