SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Changes in Tariff Schedules Which Will Result in Decreased Charges on Less Than Statutory Notice

WHEREAS: SOUTHWEST GAS CORPORATION by Advice Letter No. 77, filed October 14, 1970, having requested authority under Sections 490 and 491 of the Public Utilities Code to combine a tracking increase with a rate reduction as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 471-G to 485-G, inclusive, to be effective for meter readings on and after October 29, 1970 which is on less than statutory notice, and

WHEREAS: The result of combining the tracking increase with the rate reduction is a net decrease in rates, and

WHEREAS: Application of the net reduction on less than statutory notice for meter readings rather than service will simplify computer operations and improve customer notification, therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 490 and 491 of the Public Utilities Code to make said sheets effective for meter readings on and after October 29, 1970.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above sheets be marked to show that such sheets were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1502.
