SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Temporary Deviations From Tariff Schedules Which Will Result in Increased Charges on Less Than Statutory Notice

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY by Advice Letter No. 812, filed November 13, 1970, having requested authority under Sections 454, 490, 491 and 532 of the California Public Utilities Code to temporarily defer certain rate changes until March 31, 1971 as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 11728-G to 11730-G, inclusive, to be effective on November 30, 1970 which is on less than statutory notice, and

WHEREAS: Such moratorium for both rate increases and decreases will be accomplished by deviation from the gas tariff schedules and will result in net increased charges above normal rate levels, and

WHEREAS: Provision is made for future refunding to customers all overcharges resulting from the postponed net reductions in rate levels, and

WHEREAS: We find the temporary increases are justified and the charges to be demanded or received are just and reasonable; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Sections 454, 490, 491 and 532 of the Public Utilities Code to make said sheets effective on November 30, 1970.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above sheets be marked to show that such sheets were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1505.
