SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Changes in Gas Tariff Schedules Which Will Result in Increased Charges on Less Than Statutory Notice

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY by Advice Letter No. 815, filed December 10, 1970, requests authority under Sections 454, 491 and 532 of the Public Utilities Code to amend Schedule No. G-61, Wholesale Natural Gas Service and the dependent Gas Service Agreement Form applicable to San Diego Gas & Electric Company as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 11825-G to 11830-G, inclusive to provide for a temporary additional peaking gas supply during the winter period commencing December 1, 1970 and extending through March 15, 1971, to become effective on November 1, 1970 which is less than statutory notice, and

WHEREAS: The additional peaking gas at the level agreed to is required by San Diego Gas & Electric Company this winter because of delays in the scheduled construction and operation of its second liquefied natural gas facility, and

WHEREAS: The requested effective date of November 1, 1970 coincides with the anniversary date of the San Diego Gas & Electric Company Gas Service Agreement, and

WHEREAS: We find these increases are justified; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Sections 454, 491 and 532 of the Public Utilities Code to make the above revisions to the Gas Service Agreement Form and to Schedule G-61 effective as of November 1, 1970.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above sheets be marked to show that they were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1508.
