SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Changes in Gas Tariff Schedules Which Will Result in Increased Charges on Less Than Statutory Notice

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY by Advice Letter No. 816, filed December 17, 1970, requests authority under Sections 454, 491 and 532 of the Public Utilities Code to amend Schedule No. G-60, Resale Natural Gas Service and to file the Eighth Supplemental Service Agreement between the utility and the City of Long Beach as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 11831-G to 11873-G, inclusive to provide for an increase in Long Beach's daily contract demand from a maximum of 42,500 Mcf to 60,000 Mcf per day, and an annual contract quantity limitation of not to exceed the equivalent of 42,500 Mcf per day taken each day for the contract year, to become effective on December 1, 1970 which is less than statutory notice, and

WHEREAS: Additional peaking gas supply is also continued but increased to 20,000 Mcf per day during the winter period commencing December 1, 1970 and extending through March 15, 1971, with resulting essentially proportional changes in the charge for this service, and

WHEREAS: Long Beach entered into this agreement pursuant to Resolution No. C-20849, Resolutions of the City Council of City of Long Beach, in order to meet anticipated increased requirements on its system while facing a substantial decline in expected availability of own-source gas, and

WHEREAS: The requested effective date of December 1, 1970 coincides with the anniversary date of the Long Beach Gas Service Agreement, and

WHEREAS: We find these increases are justified, therefore, good cause appearing;

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Sections 454, 491 and 532 of the Public Utilities Code to make said sheets effective as of December 1, 1970.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above sheets be marked to show that they were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1509.
