SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Changes in Gas Tariff Schedules Which Will Result in Increased Charges on Less Than Statutory Notice

WHEREAS: PACIFIC LIGHTING SERVICE COMPANY by Advice Letter No. 58, filed January 4, 1971, requests authority under Sections 454 and 491 of the Public Utilities Code to amend Schedule No. G-62 as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 316-G to 328-G, inclusive to provide for the rate of return to be calculated by that adopted as reasonable for purposes of authorizing rates for Southern California Gas Company, to become effective on January 1, 1971, which is less than statutory notice, and

WHEREAS: This tariff modification is requested in order to permit Pacific Lighting Service Company to actually earn the rate of return found to be reasonable by recent Commission decisions, and

WHEREAS: The requested effective date of January 1, 1971 is in order to allow the billings for the full calendar year 1971 to be rendered on the new basis, and

WHEREAS: We find these increases are justified, therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Sections 454 and 491 of the Public Utilities Code to make said sheets effective as of January 1, 1971.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above sheets be marked to show that they were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1511.
