SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Changes in Gas Tariff Schedule Which Will Result in Increased Charges on Less Than Required Notice

WHEREAS: GARBERVILLE GAS CORP. by Advice Letter No. 18, filed January 21, 1971, requests authority under Section 532 of the Public Utilities Code to amend Schedule No. G-1, General Service, as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 86-G and 87-G to provide for an increase in the effective rate to become effective on January 31, 1971, which is less than required notice, and

WHEREAS: This increase is requested to offset an increase in the posted price of propane by the company's supplier in the amount of \$0.01 per gallon, and

WHEREAS: The requested effective date of January 31, 1971 is 30 days after the effective date of increased cost for propane, and

WHEREAS: We find these increases are justified, therefore good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 532 of the Public Utilities Code to make said sheets effective as of January 31, 1971.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above sheets be marked to show that they were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1513.
