SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Revised Deviations from Filed Tariffs
for a Gas Main Extension

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY by Advice Letter No. 610-G, filed January 26, 1971, having requested authority under its Rule No. 15, Section E.7., and Sections 490 and 532 of the Public Utilities Code to deviate from its filed tariff schedules by revising the previously authorized prerequisites to the extension of natural gas service to the communities of Valley Springs and San Andreas, Calaveras County as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 8571-G and 8572-G, and

WHEREAS: This revision to the authorized deviations from filed tariff schedules for this main extension will not place any burden on existing customers; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Sections 490 and 532 of the Public Utilities Code to make said sheets effective on February 25, 1971.
