SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Revisions in Tariff Schedules

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY by Advice Letter No. 826, filed April 1, 1971, having requested authority under Sections Nos. 455 and 532 of the Public Utilities Code to revise Schedules Nos. G-55, G-55A and G-56 and related contract forms as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 12205-G to 12215-G, inclusive, and

WHEREAS: The customers taking service under these schedules were advised of these revisions to omit from the above schedules and related contract forms all references to rate ceilings after December 31, 1975, and

WHEREAS: These revisions will bring the above schedules in conformity with Schedules Nos. G-58 and G-58A wherein similar deletions were made pursuant to Decisions Nos. 76067 and 76068 in Applications Nos. 51054 and 51055, respectively, and

WHEREAS: Both the effective "A" rates and the "S" rates of Schedules Nos. G-55, G-55A and G-56 have now exceeded the respective ceiling rates, applicable through December 31, 1975, due to rate increases authorized by Commission decisions, and

WHEREAS: This filing will not result in the increase of any rates or charges, cause the withdrawal of service, nor conflict with other schedules; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 532 of the Public Utilities Code to make the above sheets effective on May 1, 1971.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above sheets be marked to show that such sheets were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1521.
