SUBJECT: Order Rejecting Tariff Filing

WHEREAS: SAN DIEGO GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY by Advice Letter No. 265-G, filed June 1, 1971, having requested authority under Section No. 454 of the Public Utilities Code and Section VI of General Order No. 96-A to increase the "Contract Volumetric Rate" of Schedule No. G-54 as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 1248-G and 1249-G, and

WHEREAS: This revision to Schedule No. G-54 could result in a maximum possible estimated revenue increase to the utility's Gas Department of \$198,550 in the fiscal year July 1, 1971 to June 30, 1972, and

WHEREAS: On June 14, 1971, San Diego's sole supplier, namely, Southern California Gas Company has protested this filing pursuant to the provisions of Paragraph III.H. of General Order No. 96-A and requested that the Commission enter upon a hearing in this filing, and

WHEREAS: Southern California Gas Company filed its Application No. 52696, on June 18, 1971, which included a plan for level of service to San Diego's electric generating plants, therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be denied under Section No. 454 of the Public Utilities Code and under Section VI of General Order No. 96-A.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that San Diego's proposal be incorporated into Application No. 52696.
