SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Changes in Gas Tariff Schedules Which Deviate from Filed Tariff Schedules

WHEREAS: LAKE COUNTY UTILITY COMPANY by Advice Letter No. 6, filed June 23, 1971, requests authority under Sections 491 and 532 of the Public Utilities Code to revise Schedule No. G-80, General Service, as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 47-G and 48-G to provide for an increase in the effective rate to become effective for meter readings on and after July 15, 1971, and

WHEREAS: This increase is requested to offset an increase in the posted price of propane by the company's supplier from \$0.1078 per gallon to \$0.1158 per gallon, effective November 1, 1970, and

WHEREAS: The amount of rate increase is in conformity with the fuel escalation clause of the filed gas tariffs, and

WHEREAS: The requested effective date of July 15, 1971 by being more than 30 days after the effective date for increased cost of propane actually defers the use of the higher effective rates; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Sections 491 and 532 of the Public Utilities Code to make said sheets effective as of July 15, 1971.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above sheets be marked to show that they were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1524.
