SUBJECT: Order Suspending Tarifif Filing

WHEREAS: SAN DIEGO GAS \& ELECTRIC COMPANY by Advice Letter No. 269-G, filed August 18, 1971, having requested authority under Section 490 of the Puilic Utilities Code to revise Schedules G-1, G-2, G-3, G-4, G-11, G-40, G-50, G-51 and G-54, as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 1270-G to $2180 \cdots$, inclusive, and to file a supplenentary rate sheet for Special Contract 186, and

WHEREAS: The purpose of these revisions is to adjust the utility's gas schedules and Special Contract 186 to reflec' the net effect of a cracking rate increase and a rate decrease in Schedule G-6l filed by Southern California Gas Company in its Advice No. 832, both due to FPC filings by Transwestern Pipeline Company, and

WHEREAS: The increase porion of this filing falls under the jurisdicion of Executive Order No. 11615 issued by President Nixon on August 15, 1971, imposing a freeze on price increases, and

WHEREAS: We understand that Transwestern's increase will not go into erfect due to the Executive Order, and

WHEREAS: We find that this filing should be suspended; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be denied under Section 490 of the Public Utilities Code and that this filing be suspended for the duration or the Executive Order and extensions thereof.
