> SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Changes in Gas Tariff Schedules on Less Than Statutory Notice

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY by Advice Letter No. 833, filed October 12, 1971, having requested authority under Sections 455 and 491 of the Public Utilities Code to revise Schedule No. G-61 and the related sample form of service agreement with San Diego Gas & Electric Company as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 12531-G to 12536-G, inclusive, and

WHEREAS: The purpose of these revisions is to incorporate changes resulting from an executed letter agreement of October 4, 1971, between the two utilities, and

WHEREAS: The revisions provide for a reduction in the maximum daily amount of additional peaking demand gas, and

WHEREAS: The total annual gross revenue reduction resulting from these revisions is estimated to be \$357,800, and

WHEREAS: Southern California Gas Company requests that this filing become effective on November 1, 1971, which is the anniversary date of the service agreement; therefore good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 491 of the California Public Utilities Code to make the above sheets effective on November 1, 1971.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above sheets shall be marked to show that such sheets were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1535.
