SUBJECT: Order Suspending Tariff Filing

WHEREAS: SAN DIEGO GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY by Advice Letter No. 272-G, filed November 5, 1971, having requested authority under Decision No. 78523, dated April 12, 1971 in Application No. 51674 to revise Schedules G-1, G-2, G-3, G-4, G-11, G-40, G-50, G-51 and G-54 as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 1287-G to 1297-G, inclusive, and to file a supplementary rate sheet for Special Contract 186, and

WHEREAS: The purpose of these revisions is to adjust the utility's gas schedules and Special Contract 186 to reflect the net effect of a tracking rate increase and a rate decrease in Schedule G-61 filed by Southern California Gas Company in its Advice No. 835, both due to FPC filings by Transwestern Pipeline Company, and

WHEREAS: This filing modifies and supersedes Advice Letter No. 269-G, which was suspended by the Commission on August 31, 1971 by Resolution No. G-1532 and further suspended indefinitely on November 10, 1971 by Resolution No. G-1536 and which is subsequently being withdrawn by the utility, and

WHEREAS: The President of the United States announced on October 7, 1971 that guidelines would be presented and administrative procedures instituted to process authority to change various prices and wages, and

WHEREAS: We find that this filing should be suspended; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be denied under Section 490 of the Public Utilities Code and that this filing be suspended pending further order by this Commission.
