SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Changes in Gas Tariff Schedules Which Will Result in Increases and Decreased Charges on Less Than Statutory Notice.

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY by Advice Letter No. 622-G, filed January 20, 1972 requests authority under Sections 454 and 491 of the Public Utilities Code to revise the Preliminary Statement as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 8722-G and 8723-G to provide that a reduction in the cost of gas purchased from Pacific Gas Transmission Company (PGT) be made effective on February 4, 1972 which is less than statutory notice and to further provide an increase by extending the El Paso Natural Gas Company (El Paso) tracking increase to the air conditioning rates, and

WHEREAS: The early application of the PGT rate reduction benefits the customers by offsetting the El Paso tracking increase, and

WHEREAS: Extending the El Paso tracking increase to the air conditioning rates will maintain present rates, simplify billing procedures and avoid confusion to customers, and

WHEREAS: We find these increases are justified; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Sections 454 and 491 of the Public Utilities Code to make said sheets effective as of February 4, 1972.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above sheets be marked to show that they were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1550.
