SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Revision in Tariff Schedules

WHEREAS: SAN DIEGO GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY by Advice Letter No. 282-G, filed June 1, 1972, having requested authority under Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to obtain authorization to file a revision to Schedule G-90, Service to Utility Employees, as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 1386-G and 1387-G, and

WHEREAS: The revisions proposed would place restrictive conditions on employees or annuitants in that they could be removed from the discount provisions of said schedule for discontinuance of service due to non-payment of bills, and

WHEREAS: This could result in increased rates for those affected by these provisions, and

WHEREAS: The revenue increase will be negligible compared to the total revenue of the utility, thereby avoiding an inflationary effect on the economy, and

WHEREAS: Such increased charges as will result from said revisions are hereby found to be consistent with the purposes of the Economic Stabilization Act of 1970, as amended; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 454 of the Public Utilities Code to make the above sheets effective on July 1, 1972.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above sheets be marked to show that such sheets were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1553.
