**SUBJECT:** Order Authorizing Revision of Existing Agreement on  
Less Than Statutory Notice

**WHEREAS:** SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY by Advice Letter No. 852, filed on July 17, 1972, having requested authority under Section XA of General Order No. 96-A, and under Sections 454, 491 and 532 of the Public Utilities Code to file a letter agreement, dated July 11, 1972 between Southern Cal and San Diego Gas & Electric Company, and

**WHEREAS:** The letter agreement amends the provisions of an existing agreement executed by the two parties on December 15, 1971 on a standard agreement form previously authorized by the Commission, and

**WHEREAS:** The purpose of the amendments is to defer delivery to San Diego of approximately 2.5 to 3.0 M<sup>3</sup>cf of special purpose gas which Southern Cal obtains from Pacific Gas and Electric Company, and

**WHEREAS:** This special purpose gas will be deferred during the period July through December, 1972 and will be made available to San Diego during the period April 1, 1973 through July 31, 1973, and

**WHEREAS:** Pacific Gas and Electric Company has agreed to store this deferred special purpose gas for the period in question for a fee of 15¢ per Mcf, and

**WHEREAS:** The rate of 65.3¢ per Mcf charged to San Diego for all deferred gas deliveries represents the sum of the existing rate of 50.3¢ per Mcf plus PG&E's storage fee, and

**WHEREAS:** The negotiated price for deferred delivery is based on a sharing of the savings made possible by eliminating conflicts of delivery schedule with fuel oil commitments, and
