SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Deviation from Filed Tariffs for a Gas Main Extension on Less Than Statutory Notice

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY by Advice Letter No. 630-G, filed August 18, 1972, having requested authority under Sections 491 and 532 of the Public Utilities Code to deviate from its filed tariff rules by requiring performance deposits in the extension of natural gas service to Wooded Acres Subdivision, Shasta County, within the existing Shasta Rate Area, and

WHEREAS: Such deviations from filed tariff rules will facilitate procurement of the necessary applications for natural gas service, and

WHEREAS: The terms of the proposed gas service extension are the same, except as to the minimum number of applicants, as have been previously authorized by the Commission for other gas main extensions, and

WHEREAS: The utility is desirous of proceeding with solicitations as quickly as possible in hopes of completing construction prior to the 1972-1973 heating season; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Sections 491 and 532 of the Public Utilities Code for the utility to immediately commence soliciting applicants for gas service in the Wooded Acres Subdivision under the terms outlined in Advice Letter No. 630-G.
