SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Deviations from Filed Tariffs for a Gas Main Extension

WHEREAS: PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY by Advice No. 631-G, filed September 13, 1972, having requested authority under its Rule No. 15, Section E.7., Rule No. 16, Section I.1., and under Section 532 of the Public Utilities Code to deviate from its filed tariff schedules by requiring performance deposits and special rates in the extension of natural gas service to the town of Tranquillity, Fresno County as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 8859-G to 8863-G, inclusive, and

WHEREAS: Such deviations from filed tariff schedules will facilitate procurement of the necessary applications for natural gas service and will reduce the risk of exposing the utility to an uneconomical extension which would thereby become a burden on other ratepayers; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 532 of the Public Utilities code to make said sheets effective on October 13, 1972.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above sheets be marked to show that such sheets were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1562.
