**SUBJECT:** Order Authorizing Changes in Gas Cost of Service  
Tariff Schedules on Less Than Statutory Notice

**WHEREAS:** PACIFIC LIGHTING SERVICE COMPANY by Advice Letter No. 60, filed October 27, 1972 requests authority under Section 491 of the Public Utilities Code to revise Schedule G-62 as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 331-G and 332-G to be made effective on November 10, 1972, which is less than statutory notice, and

**WHEREAS:** The revision consists of the addition of a new account, namely, Account 183.2 which will be used to transfer those funds which are not subject to amortization, from Account 183.1 to Account 183.2, and

**WHEREAS:** The need for existing Account 183.1 in Schedule G-62 was established by the Commission with Resolution No. G-1522, dated May 25, 1971, and

**WHEREAS:** The accounting procedure set forth herein will facilitate identification between the two different types of projects and will be consistent with the Commission's Decision No. 80430; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 491 of the Public Utilities Code to make the above sheets effective as of November 10, 1972.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above sheets be marked to show that they were issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1563.
