SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Revision of Existing Contracts on Less Than Statutory Notice

WHEREAS: SAN DIEGO GAS & ELECTRIC COMPANY by Advice Letter No. 289-G, filed on October 19, 1972, having requested authority under Section XB of General Order No. 96-A and under the provisions of Section 491 of the Public Utilities Code to file two amendments to Special Contract 129 between the utility and the United States Navy, and

WHEREAS: The utility requested and received approval from the Navy to provide gas service to St. Charles Priory via gas service extension utilizing facilities relegated to the Navy, and

WHEREAS: The two amendments submitted herewith reflect the reduction in monthly facilities charge to the navy as calculated by proportionate use of the facilities between the Navy and St. Charles Priory, and

WHEREAS: The utility requests that the two amendments be accepted for filing with an effective date of January 1, 1972 thus constituting less than statutory notice, and

WHEREAS: The fulfillment of the two amendments will not result in a burden on other ratepayers or in the establishment of any reasonable differences as to rates, charges, services or facilities except to the extent authorized by Section XB of General Order No. 96-A; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Special Contract 129, as amended, be accepted for filing under the provisions of Section 491 of the Public Utilities Code with an effective date of January 1, 1972.
