SUBJECT: Order Authorizing a Gas Service Contract Under Terms
Deviating From Filed Tariffs

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY by Advice No. 856 filed November 13, 1972, having requested authority under Section XA of General Order No. 96-A and under Section 532 of the Public Utilities Code to carry out the terms of a contract with Witco Chemical for gas service under terms which deviate from filed tariffs, and

WHEREAS: The deviation requested is a waiver of the initial three-year contract requirement contained in Special Condition 4 of Rate Schedule G-53T, and

WHEREAS: Witco having been a steady customer since 1929 was recently required to elect a new schedule due to the cancellation of Schedule G-53 under the provisions of Decision No. 80430, dated August 29, 1972 in Application No. 52696; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Section 532 of the Public Utilities Code for Southern California Gas Company to carry out the terms and conditions of the above contract effective as of December 13, 1972.
