SUBJECT: Order Authorizing Rate Increases on Less Than Statutory Notice

WHEREAS: SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY by Advice Letter No. 857, filed November 20, 1972, requests authority under Section 454, 491 and 532 of the Public Utilities Code to revise Schedule G-61 and the respective Service Agreement form for wholesale service to San Diego Gas & Electric Company as set forth on Cal. P.U.C. Sheets Nos. 13468-G through 13473-G, inclusive, to be made effective on November 1, 1972, which is less than statutory notice, and

WHEREAS: SoCal is willing to provide the required peaking service pending the Commission resolution of the issue as to whether such gas is additive to the total volumes deliverable under other provisions of the gas service agreement, and

WHEREAS: The revisions primarily provide for an increase in the daily and annual amounts of peaking gas with a potential annual gross revenue increase of \$261,600, and

WHEREAS: SoCal requests that this filing become effective on November 1, 1972 which is the anniversary date of the service agreement, and

WHEREAS: The price increases in this filing are considered to be exclusions from the Federal Price Commission criteria under Rule 23.1(E)(1)(b)(ii) of the CPUC Rules of Practice and Procedure, and

WHEREAS: We find that such increases are justified; therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that authority be granted under Sections 454 and 491 of the Public Utilities Code to make the above sheets effective on November 1, 1972.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the above sheets shall be marked to show that such sheets were so issued under Resolution of the Public Utilities Commission of the State of California No. G-1566.
